

Gunn-Paly Oregon Shakespeare Festival Trip

April 1-4 2010

• Total expenses for the trip, which include round-trip bus transportation, **three** nights lodging at the Columbia Hotel, tickets to the **five** plays, **two** workshops, set **changeover** in Bowmer theatre, Saturday **brunch**, and **discussions** will be **\$500.00**. EXCEPT FOR THE BRUNCH, FOOD EXPENSES ARE NOT INCLUDED IN THIS AMOUNT.

• *Plan accordingly: We will return home at 5pm on April 4th, which is Easter Sunday. Passover will start on Tuesday, the 30th of March and will continue for 7 days until Monday, the 5th of April.*

• There are twenty-one places for Gunn students on the trip and twenty-one for Paly students.

• Only active and involved theatre students are eligible. You must be working on or off stage for two of the three Gunn Theatre productions this year.

• We will travel by chartered bus.

• This is a District-approved field trip. You will be missing two days of school: Thursday April 1st and Friday April 2nd. You will be responsible for all work missed as a result of participation in this activity.

• We will stay at the Columbia Hotel on Main Street in Ashland, Oregon.

• We will see the following plays presented by the Oregon Shakespeare Festival:

• Our group will also enjoy an actor-led acting workshop, pre-show warm-ups and post show discussions, a celebratory brunch with members of the company whom we invite, as well as a one hour pre-brunch discussion by a selected company member. There will be a limited number of Backstage Tours available.

• You may reserve a place by filling out the accompanying application and attaching a CHECK for \$250.00, payable to GUNN THEATRE BOOSTERS as deposit towards your total expenses. We will collect deposit checks and create a waiting list on Tuesday January 26th at lunch in D-14.
